Things to Keep in Mind


- Locations of existing and future power points, plumbing, light fixtures etc.
- Check if the floor is level.
- The amount of room that doors and windows need to open.
- The size of your washing machine & dryer, including recommended clearance.
- Access points for installation where will the cabinets be carried in from?

What to Measure in your Laundry


- Overall size of laundry.
- Wall to wall. Don't forget to allow for tiles if the walls haven't been tiled yet.
- Size and location of doors and windows.
- Waste and/or pipe positions.

Use the draft planning grid to sketch out your Laundry ideas freely, or cut out the scale drawings and planning grid on the following pages to plan your laundry layout more accurately






